

First Speaker: Dr. Ha-Joon Chang



Dr. Ha-Joon Chang is a Korean institutionalist political economist specialising in development economics. Currently based at the University of Cambridge, Dr. Chang is the author of several widely-discussed policy books, most notably Kicking Away the Ladder: Development Strategy in Historical Perspective (2002). Dr. Chang was ranked by Prospect magazine as one of the top 10 World Thinkers in 2013.

Second Speaker: Dr. Neva Makgetla



Dr. Neva Makgetla has been Programme Manager: Trade and Industrial Policy at Trade and Industrial Policy Strategies (TIPS) from November 2014. She was Deputy Director-General for Economic Policy in the Economic Development Department from 2010 to 2014. Before joining EDD, Makgetla worked for the Presidency, the DBSA and COSATU as well as other government departments. Prior to 1994 she worked in various universities in Africa and the United States. Makgetla's publications centre on socio-economic challenges facing South Africa, especially around employment creation and equity. She has also participated in a number of high-level policy processes on these topics.

Mr. Imraan Patel is the Deputy Director-General: Socio-Economic Partnerships for the Department of Science and Technology (DST). He is responsible for strategically driving a portfolio of investments and policies that advances the social and economic development priorities of government through science and technology-based interventions.

He also represents DST on the social and economic clusters of government and the advisory committee for the Green Fund. He is also a member of the board of MINTEK, the Water Research Commission and Trade and Industrial Policy Strategies (TIPS).
